1346-1378	—	Emperor Charles
1526-1867	—	Habsburg Empire
1346-1378	—	Jews limited to Ghetto
1526-1609	—	Maharal - Golem Myth
1576-1612	—	Rudolph II - Golden Age
1780-1790	—	Joseph II - end of laws humiliating Jews
1918	—	formation of Czechoslovakia
1919	—	President Masaryk grants full rights to Jews
1919-1935	—	President Masaryk
1941-1945	—	139,000 Jews sent to Terezin Concentration Camp
May 1942	—	Assassination of Heydrich - wave of Terror
1948-1989	—	Communist Rule
1989	—	Velvet Revolution
1992	—	Break up of Czechoslovakia
