

USEFUL **HEBREW** WORDS AND PHRASES

In Hebrew there are both masculine and feminine grammatical conjunctions. Please note that when there are two forms of a word, (m) connotes the masculine form and (f) the feminine one. The letters "ch" indicate a guttural sound, similar to the sound heard when clearing one's throat. It exists in many languages, although not in English (e.g. ch in Scottish "loch", as in "Chanukah", or like the Spanish jota). Remember that Hebrew is read from right to left, so if you are reading the Hebrew script, start from the right! However, you can read the Hebrew transliteration the same way you read English. Behatzlacha! Good luck!
