Pronunciation Notes • 'J' is pronounced as 'ch' in 'chutzpah', e.g. Jerusalén – che-russalen

• 'H' in Spanish is silent: 'hola' (hi) is pronounced "ola" • 'LL' is pronounced as 'Y': Pollo (chicken) is pronounced 'poyo'

5 vowels: **A** = fAther (ah) | **E** = stEp (eh) | **I** = fEEt (ee) | **O** = British 'stOp' (oh) | **U** = bOOt
