Day of Wrath. 2005. Director: Adrian Rudomin

A sheriff in 16th century Spain works to uncover a plot, while keeping his Jewish origins a secret.

Goya's Ghosts. 2006. Director: Milos Forman

The story of the painter Goya during the Spanish Inquisition when his muse, Ines, is arrested by the Holy Office of the Inquisition for practicing Jewish rituals.

El Santo Oficio. 1974. Director: Arturo Ripstein.

A story of a family of conversos who secretly practice Judaism and are betrayed by a family member who brings them before the Inquisition.

Every Time We Say Goodbye. 1986. Director: Moshe Mizrahi

A story of a Gentile American in the Royal Air Force stationed in Jerusalem who falls in love with a girl whose family originally is from Spain. Partly in Ladino.
